ДОКЛАД ГЕНЕРАЛЬНОГО ДИРЕКТОРА

ПРЕДВАРИТЕЛЬНЫЙ ДОКЛАД О ПОСТУПЛЕНИЯХ И РАСХОДАХ ОЗХО ЗА ФИНАНСОВЫЙ ГОД ДО 31 ДЕКАБРЯ 2009 ГОДА

- 1. В пункте 14.1 доклада о работе своей сорок первой сессии (документ ЕС-41/5 от 1 июля 2005 года) Исполнительный совет (далее "Совет") принял к сведению доклад о работе восемнадцатой сессии Консультативного органа по административным и финансовым вопросам (документ ABAF-18/1 от 13 мая 2005 года), включая его мнение, что Генеральному директору следует ежеквартально представлять Совету доклады о поступлениях и расходах.
- 2. Генеральный директор настоящим представляет Совету в виде приложений к настоящему докладу следующие подробные отчеты, в которых показаны поступления и расходы ОЗХО за 2009 финансовый год до конца его четвертого квартала и содержится информация за предыдущие годы в тех случаях, когда это полезно для целей сопоставления или разъяснения:

а) состояние поступлений:

- i) Приложение 1: Состояние распределенных ежегодных взносов государств-членов на 31 декабря 2009 года;
- ii) Приложение 2: Многолетние планы платежей, утвержденные Конференцией государств-участников по состоянию на 31 декабря 2009 года (документ C-12/DEC.7 от 7 ноября 2007 года);
- ііі) Приложение 3: Государства-члены, за которыми по состоянию на 31 декабря 2009 года числилась задолженность по ежегодным распределенным взносам за предыдущие годы в сумме, которая равнялась или превышала сумму взносов, причитающихся с них за 2007 и 2008 годы;
- iv) Приложение 4: Причитающиеся распределенные ежегодные взносы подписавших Конвенцию государств в ОЗХО по состоянию на 31 декабря 2009 года;

- v) Приложение 5: Возмещение расходов на инспекции, по которым выставлены счета-фактуры, согласно статьям IV и V Конвенции о химическом оружии за финансовый год до 31 декабря 2009 года; и

- 3. В течение финансового года до настоящего времени Технический секретариат (далее "Секретариат") не привлекал средств из фонда оборотных средств (ФОС). Сумма средств в ФОС на отчетную дату составляла 9 912 981 евро³.
- 4. Все суммы, указанные в настоящем документе, приведены в евро. Информация за предыдущие годы для целей сопоставления отражает ситуацию на конец соответствующего года или за весь год.

Paragraph 8 of Article VIII of the Chemical Weapons Convention (hereinafter "the Convention") states the following: "A member of the Organization which is in arrears in the payment of its financial contribution to the Organization shall have no vote in the Organization if the amount of its arrears equals or exceeds the amount of the contribution due from it for the preceding two full years." In assessing Member States' voting rights in any given year, the Secretariat, following past practice, does not factor into its calculation of arrears any amounts still outstanding for the current year, and takes into account only amounts outstanding from annual assessments for previous years. Member States that joined the Convention during the preceding two years are not included in this assessment.

This minimum payment is required so that arrears are reduced to an amount that does not exceed the amount of contributions due from the Member State for 2007 and 2008, pursuant to paragraph 8 of Article VIII of the Convention. Any arrears from Member States relating to the Preparatory Commission or the WCF have not been included in the minimum payment required. The OPCW's Financial Regulation 5.6(a), as amended by the Conference (C-9/DEC.11, dated 2 December 2004) requires that payments made to the OPCW by a Member State, other than contributions under Articles IV and V of the Convention, be credited first to any arrears in advances to the WCF and then to any arrears in assessed annual contributions, in the order in which these contributions were assessed.
