CURRICULUM VITAE OF CANDIDATE

Mr Mangelsdorf joined the German Federal Foreign Office in 2007. Following two postings as head of Development Cooperation and Head of Cultural Affairs to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and the Republic of South Africa respectively, he worked at the Ministry's export control division and participated in the Arms Trade Treaty negotiations. From 2013 onwards he served as Head of Economic and Trade relations at the German Embassy in Cairo. Since 2016 he has been working as coordinator for crises prevention and stabilization measures at the Ministry's headquarters. His responsibilities included the management of the Ministry's peace mediation team. Recently, he joined the Directorate General for International Order, the United Nations and Arms control, assuming responsibility for UN management and budget matters and the Fifth Committee. Hr Mangelsdorf is an economist by training and has earned degrees from the University of Leipzig und the Université Lyon 2. He specialized in accounting, controlling, macroeconomics and taxation.
