CORRESPONDENCE CONCERNING THE SEQUENCE FOR THE EXTERNAL AUDITORS OF THE OPCW FOR THE FINANCIAL YEARS 2000-2005

- 1. At its recent Fifth Session the Conference of the States Parties adopted the decision on the appointment of the External Auditors of the OPCW for the financial years 2000 2005 (C-V/DEC.24, dated 19 May 2000). In this decision the Conference resolved, inter alia, that the Auditors General of India and Pakistan respectively should serve for two consecutive periods, each of three years, with "the sequence of these to be decided by India and Pakistan".
- 2. The Secretariat annexes to this document a letter from Mr Amir A. Shadani, the Alternate Representative of Pakistan, which advises that the Auditor General of India will be the External Auditor of the OPCW for the financial years 2000 to 2002, and that the Auditor General of Pakistan will accordingly play this role for the financial years 2003 to 2005.
