## 技术秘书处的说明

## 《化学武器公约》第十条援助与防护的协调 第九期讲习班提名邀请 2006 年 10 月 18 至 20 日 乌克兰,基辅

- 1. 技术秘书处(以下称"技秘处") 谨此代表乌克兰政府和禁止化学武器组织 (禁化武组织) 邀请成员国提出人选,参加定于 2006 年 10 月 18 至 20 日在乌克兰基辅举办的关于《化学武器公约》(以下称"《公约》")第十条援助与防护的协调的第九期讲习班。
- 2. 这期讲习班将提供一个场合,使缔约国能够交流各自在实际实施第十条方面的 经验。同时希望能有来自国家主管部门、政府各部、化学工业界的参与或将会 参与对缔约国援助承诺的官员和专家聚集一堂。参加人员将回顾禁化武组织过 去两年中的援助和防护活动,并回顾在此期间第十条实施和缔约国大会(以下称"大会")第九和第十届会议有关决定(C-9/DEC.10, 2004年11月30日;及 C-10/DEC.8, 2005年11月10日)实施的进展情况。
- 3. 讲习班将利用一天时间讨论 2005 联合援助演练。这是一次援助送达演练,是乌克兰、北大西洋公约组织欧洲-大西洋救灾协调中心、禁化武组织于 2005 年 10 月 9 至 13 日在乌克兰利维夫联合组织举办的。从禁化武组织的角度,演练的目的是检验自己在《公约》第十条所指援助请求面前的现行程序,并检验自己实际作出此种反应的能力。曾参加 2005 联合援助演练的一些国家和组织的代表将在讲习班上讨论他们在该次演练中吸取的经验和教训。
- 4. 鉴于讲习班的目的及其技术性质,人选必须是在本国参与第十条实施工作的。
- 5. 讲习班将用英文举办,提供英文到俄文的口译服务。因此,希望参加人员能熟练掌握其中一种语文。

- 6. 参加人员将于 2006 年 10 月 17 日星期二抵达,并于 2006 年 10 月 21 日星期六 离开。请参加人员在前往乌克兰以前获得必要的签证(包括过境签证)。秘书 处希望能够负担一些参加人员的旅费,但人数有限。将免费向得到资助的参加 人员提供食宿。将在提名截止日期后的两个星期内与确定的人选联系。届时将 把住宿、讲习班地点和交通的进一步详细资料发给参加人员。
