Electronic Declarations before ADPA 2008

- For ADPA 2007 only seven declarations were received in electronic format
- Of these seven, two declarations were in XML format and five were in CTFS
- All electronic declarations required (minor) technical adjustments in consultation with the concerned State Party

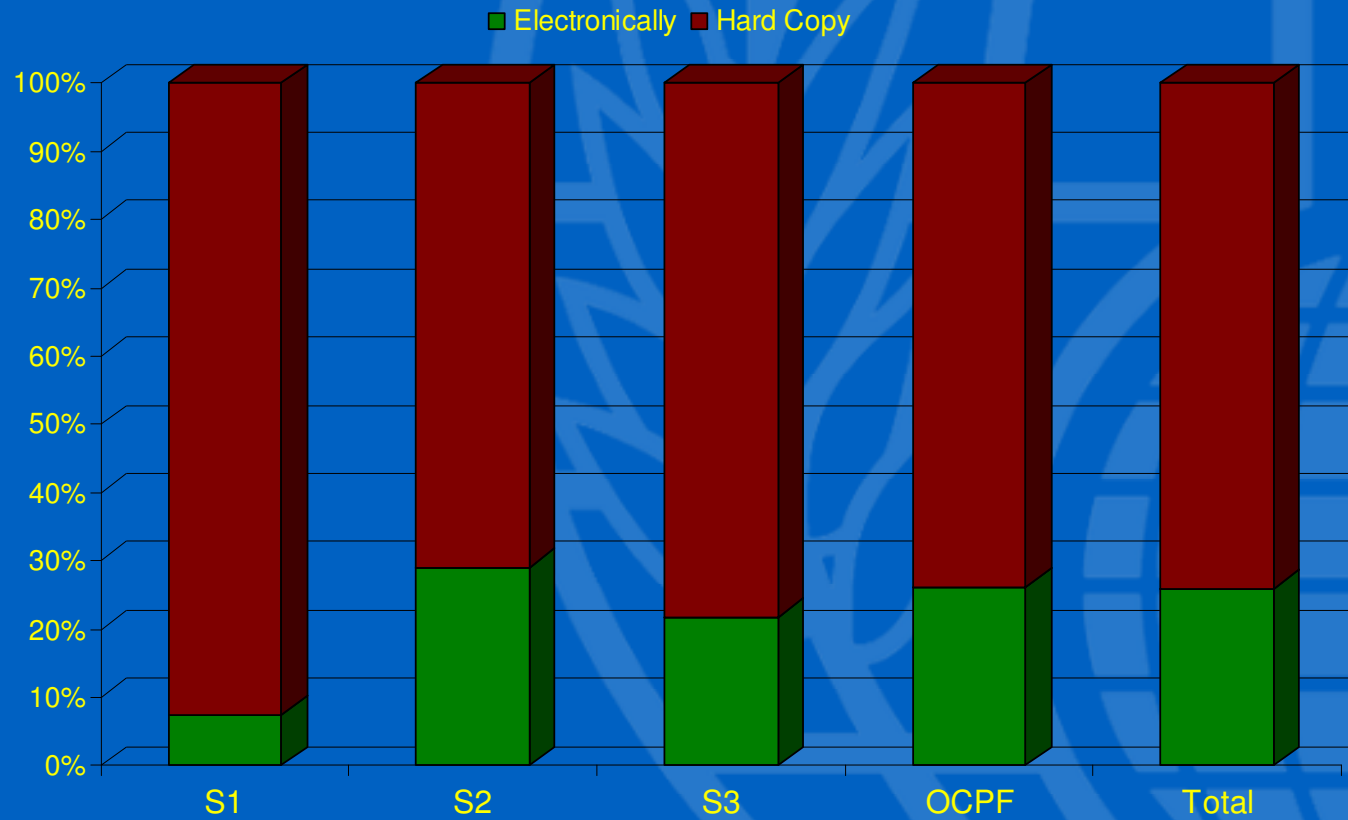
Electronic Declarations ADPA 2008

- For ADPA 2008 altogether 21 declarations were received in electronic format
- Again five declarations were in CTFS format. 16 declarations were in XML format; 12 were prepared with EDNA.
- Most EDNA declarations could be loaded into VIS without any issues.

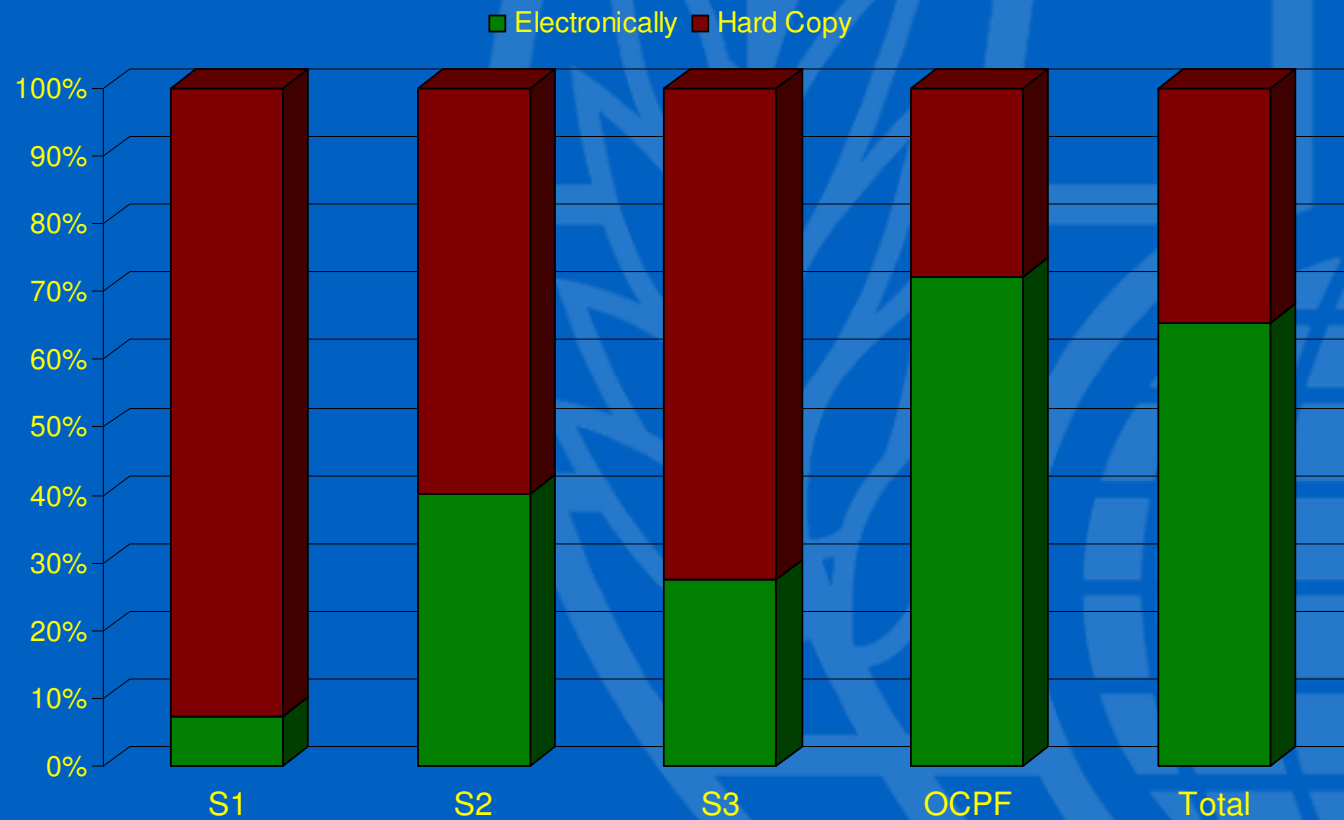
Distribution for ADPA 2007

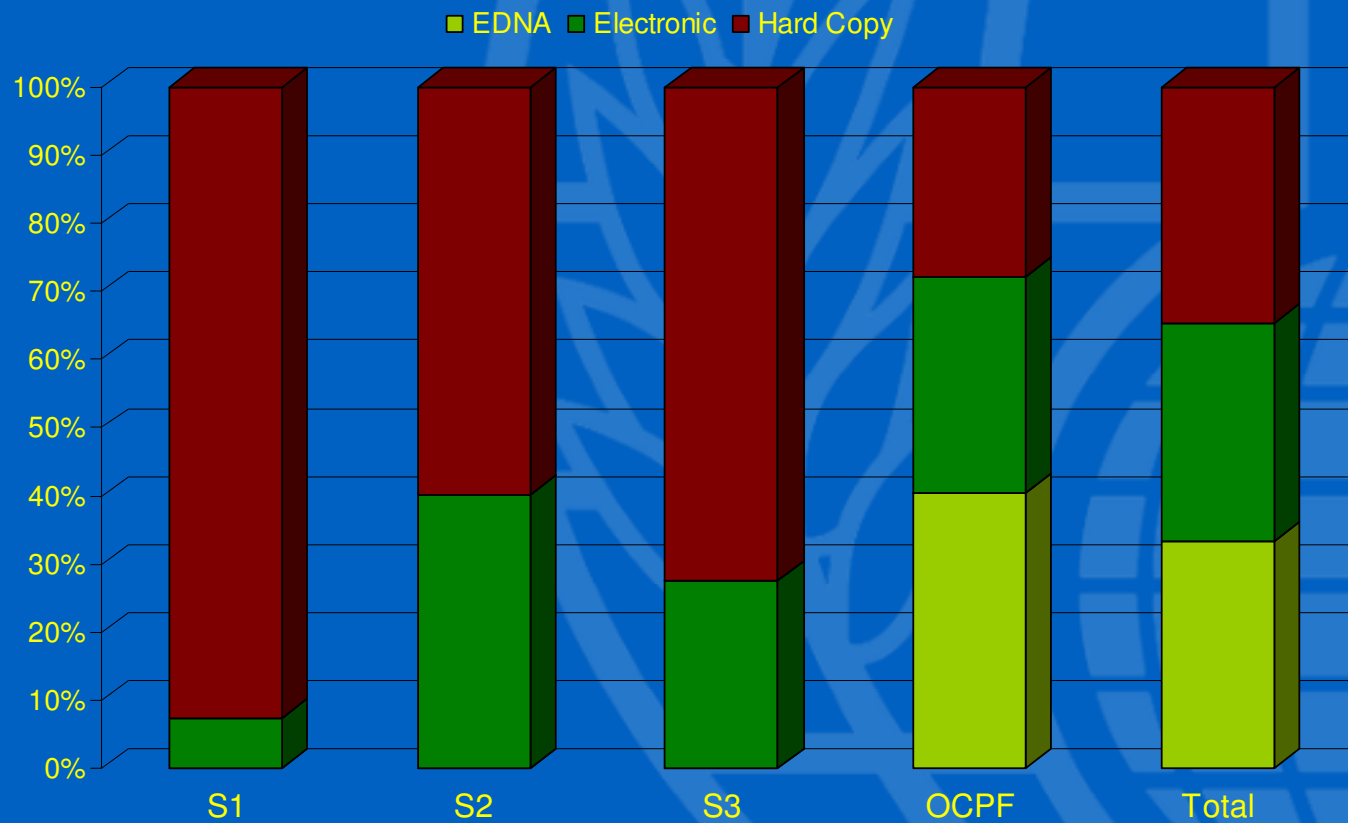
