# EDNA Version 2.0



- To be released at the National Authority Days 2009.
- EDNA Version 2.0 will cover declaration of:
  - Schedule 2 Plant Sites
  - Schedule 3 Plant Sites
  - OCPF Plant Sites, and
  - Aggregate National Data – AND
- Will not cover declaration of Schedule 1 facilities
  - Adding the option for Schedule 1 facilities will be based on requirements from National Authorities
- EDNA Version 1.x will be maintained through 2010

# EDNA Version 2.0



- Some Highlights.
  - The user interface consistent with EDNA Version 1.x
  - EDNA Version 2.0 will support ADAA and ADPA for Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 plant sites
  - Aggregate National Data – AND – can be automatically aggregated from the data entered for declared plant sites
  - The option of entering and storing also information from non-declared Plant Sites or other entities as Traders or Custom Information for the purpose of compiling AND data
- Upgrade from EDNA Version 1.x
  - The upgrade to Version 2.0 will be automated
  - No loss of data when upgrading
