### EXERCISE INSPECTION MANDATE

**To:** **Ladislav Belicky**, Inspection Team Leader

**From:** Director-General of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons.

**Subject:** Mandate for investigation of alleged use and assessment for assistance and protection

*In accordance with paragraph 9 of Article X and paragraph 1 of Part XI of the Verification Annex, I hereby mandate and instruct an inspection team under your leadership to conduct an assessment of a request for Assistance and Protection against Chemical Weapons, with the following inspection aims:*

- (a) The purpose of the inspection shall be to assess the request for assistance submitted by the State Party and determine what, if any, assistance and protection may be required. Further, the inspection shall conduct an investigation to establish facts regarding any potential use of chemical weapons against the State Party.
  - (b) The particular inspection aims are as follows:
    - a. Establish facts relevant to the request as well as the type and scope of supplementary assistance and protection needed.
    - b. Assess the situation, through on-site investigation in accordance with Part XI of the Annex on Verification, in order to provide a foundation for further action.
    - c. Assist the National Authority in coordinating activities if necessary.
