NOTE BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

REQUEST FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPECIAL FUND FOR CAPACITY BUILDING FOR LABORATORIES AND TRANSFER OF A PORTION OF THE 2017 CASH SURPLUS

- 1. The Technical Secretariat (hereinafter "the Secretariat") runs a wide range of capacity-building activities to support States Parties in the development of laboratories capable handling and analysing Chemical Weapons of Convention-related chemicals. These activities have led to significant demand for increased efforts from the Secretariat in the area of capacity building and requests for the design and roll-out of a programme to identify potential laboratories for additional support, scoping their current capabilities, assessing their needs, and providing tailor-made programming to build the requisite analytical and laboratory skills, with the support of voluntary contributions.
- 2. As stated in the Draft Programme and Budget for 2020 (EC-92/CRP.1, dated 5 July 2019), the Secretariat is preparing to augment its capacity-building activities, with a focus on assistance and protection, chemical safety and security management, and support for laboratories in developing countries or in countries with economies in transition.
- 3. Taking into consideration the emphasis placed by the States Parties during Programme and Budget consultations on the impact of assessed contributions on States Parties, the Secretariat proposes the establishment of a special fund for training and capacity-building for laboratories, financed by using a portion of the 2017 cash surplus in the amount of EUR 380,000.
- 4. The Executive Council is requested to consider this proposal and recommend to the Conference of the States Parties at its Twenty-Fourth Session that it approve the transfer to the proposed fund of a portion of the 2017 cash surplus in the amount of EUR 380,000.
