Statement by H.E. Vidmantas Purlys, Permanent Representative of Lithuania to OPCW under agenda item 6 (g) Addressing the threat of the chemical weapons use

95th Session of the Executive Council of the OPCW

(The Hague, 6-9 October 2020)

The poisoning of Mr. Alexei Navalny with a chemical nerve agent in Russia on the 20 August 2020 is a fact. It is a criminal act and blatant violation of the Chemical Weapons Convention, international law and human rights.

Poisoning with Novichok of the member of political opposition is shocking. We, regretfully, have seen the pattern previously, Salisbury being the latest horrific example.

We join all those who call on Russia to live up to its commitments under the Chemical Weapons Convention - cooperate with the OPCW, disclose its Novichok programme and destroy all chemical weapons. We also call on Russia to bring the perpetrators of this heinous crime to justice through a transparent and thorough international investigation. Impunity for such crime should not be tolerated.

We appreciate efforts by Germany to assist Mr. Navalny with a medical treatment and recovery. We also welcome assistance by the Technical Secretariat provided to Germany. We have full confidence in professionalism and impartiality of the Secretariat in conducting its work.

We reiterate our condemnation in the strongest possible terms of the use of chemical weapons by anyone under any circumstances.
