UNITED STATES OF AMERICA STATEMENT REGARDING THE ILLEGITMACY OF THE MADURO REGIME IN VENEZEUELA TO 27TH SESSION THE CONFERENCE OF THE STATES PARTIES

The members of the Venezuelan delegation here today do not represent the legitimate Government of Venezuela. They are not speaking on behalf of the Venezuelan people. The United States continues to recognize the legal authority of the democratically elected 2015 National Assembly and the person chosen by this National Assembly to be its president as the constitutional interim President of Venezuela, Juan Guaido. The Maduro regime's repression, corruption, and mismanagement have left millions of Venezuelans in need of humanitarian aid and created one of the worst economic, human rights, and migration crises outside of a war in modern history.

The United States and others around the world share a moral obligation to support the Venezuelan people. The United States welcomes continued international cooperation to develop practical and effective solutions to bring an end to the crises in Venezuela and alleviate the suffering of the Venezuelan people, including the millions who have fled Venezuela.

We look forward to collaborating in the future with a delegation that represents a government legitimately elected by the people of Venezuela.
