NOTE BY THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

WITHDRAWAL BY THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATION OF HUNGARY OF A CANDIDATE FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR-GENERAL

- 1. A Note by the Technical Secretariat (EC-109/S/4, dated 18 March 2025) was circulated to the members of the Executive Council (the Council), informing them of the nomination by the Permanent Representation of Hungary to the OPCW of H.E. Ambassador András Kocsis as candidate for the position of Director-General of the Technical Secretariat of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW).
- 2. Further to that communication, the Permanent Representation of Hungary to the OPCW informed the Chairperson, by Note Verbale No. 65/2025/HUEMB/HGA dated 18 September 2025, that the candidacy of H.E. Ambassador András Kocsis for the position of Director-General has been withdrawn.
