## **DECISION**

## APPOINTMENT OF THE FIRST EXTERNAL AUDITOR OF THE OPCW

## The Conference

**Recalling** that, in accordance with Article 13.1 of the OPCW Financial Regulations, the Conference shall appoint the External Auditor, who shall be the Auditor-General (or an officer holding an equivalent title) of a State Party and that such appointment shall be in the manner and for the period determined by the Conference and for a single period of not less than two years, but not exceeding six years,

**Recalling further** that, as indicated in C-I/DG-1 and C-I/DG-4, three nominations were received from States Parties for the External Auditor of the OPCW,

**Bearing in mind** that, in accordance with Article VIII, paragraphs 19 and 30 of the Convention, the Conference may delegate certain functions to the Executive Council,

## Hereby:

- 1. **Delegates** to the Executive Council the authority to decide the term of appointment of the first External Auditor of the OPCW, which shall be a single period of not less than two years, but not exceeding six years.
- 2. **Delegates** to the Executive Council the authority to appoint the first External Auditor of the OPCW from among the above-mentioned three nominations received from States Parties.
- 3. **Requests** the Executive Council to report to the next session of the Conference of the States Parties the decisions taken on these matters.
