NOTE BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

NEW EXTERNAL AUDITOR OF THE OPCW

- 1. The Conference of the States Parties at its Sixteenth Session re-appointed Professor Dieter Engels, President of the German Supreme Audit Institution, as External Auditor of the OPCW, to audit its financial and administrative operations for three financial years—from 2012 to 2014 (C-16/DEC.5, dated 30 November 2011).
- 2. Consequent to the retirement of Professor Engels on 8 April 2014, and to the interim succession of Mr Christian Ahrendt, Vice-President of the German Supreme Audit Institution (EC-76/DG.5, dated 15 May 2014), Mr Kay Scheller, newly appointed President of the German Supreme Audit Institution, has succeeded to the post of External Auditor of the OPCW, in accordance with Financial Regulation 13.2 (C-15/DEC.5, dated 1 December 2010), which states:

"If the External Auditor ceases to hold office as Auditor-General in his own country, his appointment as External Auditor of the OPCW shall terminate forthwith and he shall be succeeded as External Auditor by the person who succeeds him as Auditor-General in his home country. The External Auditor may not otherwise be removed during the tenure of his appointment, except by the Conference of the States Parties".

3. The term of Mr Scheller as External Auditor of the OPCW took effect on 1 July 2014 and will continue until the audit of the OPCW financial statements as at 31 December 2014 has been completed. Mr Scheller's curriculum vitae is annexed to this Note.
