INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CWC: FROM ASSISTANCE AND PROTECTION TO INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION HAVANA, CUBA, 6 - 8 JUNE 2000

- 1. The National Authority of the Republic of Cuba and the Technical Secretariat invite representatives of the National Authorities of Member States in the Latin American and the Caribbean region to participate in a regional workshop on challenges and opportunities in the implementation of the Chemical Weapons Convention, to be held in Havana, Cuba, from 6 8 June 2000.
- 2. The aims of the workshop are as follows:
 - (a) to promote a better understanding of the benefits available to States Parties under the Convention;
 - (b) to provide an overview of the status of implementation of the Convention and of unresolved issues:
 - (c) to enable the participants to develop an understanding of the purpose and importance of Article X, and of the rights and obligations of States Parties under its provisions on protection and assistance;
 - (d) to provide an overview of assistance-related issues: measures to provide assistance, with illustrative examples, and possible options for States Parties with no chemical protection programmes; and
 - (e) to outline the opportunities for international cooperation in the field of chemistry under Article XI, to identify areas of interest for future projects, and to discuss proposals for the development of a regional platform.
- 4. The provisional programme of the workshop is attached as annex 1.
- 5. Spanish English interpretation services will be available throughout the workshop.

- 6. The Secretariat will be able to sponsor a limited number of participants, to cover the costs of international travel and accommodation in Havana. Sponsored participants will be informed separately about the terms and conditions of OPCW sponsorship.
- 7. Interested representatives of National Authorities are invited to complete the attached registration form (annex 2), and to return it to the Secretariat no later than 29 April 2000, together with an indication of whether sponsorship will be required.
