# NOTE BY THE TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT

# INVITATION FOR A SEMINAR ON THE DESTRUCTION OF ADAMSITE TO BE HELD IN KRYNICA AND TARNOW, IN POLAND, FROM 26 - 28 APRIL 2000

- 1. The Government of Poland and the Secretariat of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) wish to invite representatives of Member States of the OPCW to a seminar on the destruction of adamsite. The seminar, which will also be attended by experts from the OPCW's Scientific Advisory Board, will be held in Krynica and Tarnow near Krakow, in Poland, from 26 28 April 2000.
- 2. The purpose of the seminar is to demonstrate the process developed by Poland for the destruction of adamsite. Poland decided after the entry into force of the Convention to destroy its old stock of this chemical. The completion of destruction of the adamsite was witnessed by the OPCW.
- 3. Adamsite is a non-scheduled chemical originally developed for chemical warfare purposes. It was subsequently used as a training agent and for riot control purposes, although the latter use is no longer accepted in most countries. It has no other legitimate uses.
- 4. The seminar, which will provide a framework for exchanging experiences of the technological aspects of the destruction of toxic chemicals, is intended to be the first in a series of seminars under the umbrella of the OPCW to facilitate the discussion of technical issues related to destruction technologies. It is the intention of the organisers to provide a forum for the discussion of international cooperation measures under the auspices of the OPCW, in the area of destruction technologies.
- 5. The provisional programme for the meeting is contained in annex 1 to this Note.
- 6. Participation in the seminar will be limited to a maximum of two experts from each Member State, one of whom may be eligible for sponsorship. The Secretariat will be able to sponsor a limited number of participants by covering the cost of international travel to Poland and accommodation in Poland for the seminar. Participants seeking such sponsorship will be informed separately of the terms and conditions which accompany it.
