# SEVENTH ANNUAL WORKSHOP TO COORDINATE ASSISTANCE AND PROTECTION UNDER ARTICLE X OF THE CHEMICAL WEAPONS CONVENTION STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN, 13 – 17 OCTOBER 2003

- 1. On behalf of the Government of Sweden and the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), the Technical Secretariat (hereinafter "the Secretariat") wishes to invite Member States to nominate participants to the Seventh Annual Workshop to Coordinate Assistance and Protection under Article X of the Chemical Weapons Convention, which will be held in Stockholm, Sweden, from 13 to 17 October 2003.
- 2. The workshop will provide a forum in which States Parties can share their experiences in relation to the practical implementation of Article X of the Chemical Weapons Convention on the provision of assistance and protection against chemical weapons, and review in detail the concept of the delivery of assistance that the Secretariat has developed under Article X. In addition, the National Authority of Sweden and the Swedish Rescue Services will jointly present a programme on assistance and protection that describes practices followed by the Swedish Chemical Support Team.
- 3. The workshop is intended to draw together officials and experts from National Authorities, from other government ministries, and from the chemical industry who are or will be associated with offers to deliver assistance to Member States. Participants will have the opportunity to review proposed mechanisms for coordinating the delivery of assistance and for finding practical solutions to such matters as logistics, training in the use of protective equipment, and procedures to ensure the timely delivery of assistance.
- 4. Given the purpose of the workshop and its technical nature, candidates will be carefully selected and should be involved in implementing Article X in their respective countries. Because the workshop will be taught in English, good English-language skills are also required.
- 5. Participants will arrive on Sunday, 12 October 2003, and will depart on Saturday, 18 October 2003. Participants are requested to obtain any necessary visas (including transit visas) before travelling to Sweden. The Secretariat expects to be able to cover

the travel costs of a limited number of candidates nominated by Member States. When proposing candidates for the workshop, Member States should specify whether such sponsorship is a condition of their participation. The workshop materials, as well as accommodation and all meals, will be provided free of charge. Further details about accommodation, the workshop venue, and transport will be issued to participants at a later date.

- 6. Interested Member States are invited to complete the nomination form that is included as Annex 1 to this Note, giving each nominee's full name and address, fax and telephone numbers, and e-mail address if available, together with his or her affiliation and area(s) of expertise. The completed nomination form, together with a brief curriculum vitae for each nominee, should be faxed to the Assistance and Protection Branch, International Cooperation and Assistance Division, OPCW, at +31 (0)70 416 3209. Nominations should be submitted as soon as possible, but no later than 31 July 2003, to allow sufficient time for the Secretariat and the Swedish authorities to make the necessary arrangements.
- 7. Annex 2 to this Note offers a provisional schedule for the workshop. Further details of the arrangements will be issued as soon as the International Cooperation and Assistance Division receives confirmation from participants that they will be attending the workshop.
