NOTE BY THE TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT

RELEASE OF THE OPCW CENTRAL ANALYTICAL DATABASE ON DVD

- 1. The Technical Secretariat wishes to inform Member States of the latest release of the OPCW Central Analytical Database (OCAD) on DVD. The DVD contains electronic version 7 (e-OCAD v.7) and portable data format version 9 (PDF-OCAD v.9). The on-site analytical database, OS-e-OCAD v.7, has also been included. These versions of the OCAD were prepared in accordance with a decision entitled "Proposed Mechanism for Updating the OPCW Central Analytical Database" (EC-IV/DEC.2, dated 5 September 1997), which was adopted by the Conference of the States Parties (hereinafter "the Conference") at its Second Session (subparagraph 11.2(c) of C-II/8, dated 5 December 1997). The database was certified in accordance with a decision entitled "Authentication and Certification Procedure for the OPCW Central Analytical Database and On-Site Databases", which was adopted by the Conference at its Sixth Session (C-VI/DEC.4, dated 17 May 2001).
- 2. E-OCAD v.7 contains mass-spectrometry data (MS spectra), while PDF-OCAD v.9 contains mass-spectrometry (MS), infrared-spectrometry, and nuclear-magnetic-resonance spectrometry data, as well as gas-chromatography retention indices. OS-e-OCAD v.7 contains MS data and retention indices in a combined format, and is used with OPCW equipment for on-site analysis.
- 3. These databases have been updated with those data on chemicals that were approved for inclusion in the OCAD by the Executive Council at its Thirty-Eighth and Fortieth Sessions (EC-38/DEC.10, dated 13 October 2004, and EC-40/DEC.9, dated 16 March 2005).
