NOTE BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE SWISS EXERCISE COURSE 2 SPIEZ, SWITZERLAND 19 – 23 MARCH 2012

- 1. On behalf of the Government of Switzerland and the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), the Director-General wishes to invite States Parties to nominate participants for the second Swiss exercise course on protection against chemical weapons, which will be held at the Nuclear, Biological, Chemical Training Centre in Spiez, Switzerland, from 19 to 23 March 2012.
- 2. The activity is related to the offer made by Switzerland, under Article X of the Chemical Weapons Convention (hereinafter "the Convention"), to provide assistance and protection against chemical weapons, and will be jointly organised by the Government of Switzerland and the Technical Secretariat (hereinafter "the Secretariat"). Up to 30 specialists from Member States will be invited to take part in this exercise course.
- 3. The course, which draws on Switzerland's extensive experience in this area, is intended for specialists who are, or who will be, associated with the training of civilians in their home countries in protection against chemical weapons. The main objectives of the course are:
 - (a) to train the trainers;
 - (b) to provide the participants with necessary know-how on field procedures as instructors;
 - (c) to provide training on the proper use of individual protective equipment, monitoring and detection techniques, decontamination techniques, and sampling and detection methods used by the mobile field laboratory during field exercises.
- 4. Given the purpose of the course and its technical nature, candidates will be carefully selected. Attendance of the previous Swiss courses (Swiss basic, advanced and/or laboratory courses) will be a precondition for selection of participants.

- 5. The Secretariat expects to be able to sponsor a limited number of participants from States Parties. Each nomination should specify whether sponsorship is a condition of the nominee's participation. For sponsored participants, the Secretariat will cover the costs of travel and medical insurance, and will provide a limited subsistence allowance to cover sundry expenses. The course materials, accommodation, and all meals during the course will be provided by the Government of Switzerland to all participants at no cost to them or the OPCW. Further details regarding accommodation, the course venue, and transport will be provided at a later date.
- 6. When making travel arrangements for sponsored participants, the Secretariat will seek the most economic options. Sponsored participants will be allowed to purchase tickets locally only if doing so leads to further savings for the Secretariat and if it authorises it. Participants are expected to arrive on Sunday, 18 March 2012, and to depart on Saturday, 24 March 2012. The Secretariat's approval is required for any changes to the dates on which sponsored participants arrive and depart. The Secretariat will not cover expenses unrelated to the course or that result from unauthorised changes to travel arrangements. Sponsored participants shall bear all costs resulting from changes they make, including cancellations, once the Secretariat has purchased their tickets. Participants who have not been sponsored are requested to make their own travel arrangements.
- 7. The course will be conducted in English, and no interpretation services of any kind will be provided. Participants are therefore expected to have a good written and oral command of English.
- 8. Participants are requested to obtain any necessary visas, including transit visas, before travelling to Switzerland.
- 9. Interested applicants are invited to complete the nomination form that is included as Annex 2 to this Note, making sure in particular to provide all contact details. Completed forms should be sent, along with a brief curriculum vitae, to the Director, International Cooperation and Assistance Division, OPCW, Johan de Wittlaan 32, 2517 JR The Hague, the Netherlands. - 10. Those who have been selected to participate will be contacted no later than two weeks after the submission deadline. States Parties are requested to inform the International Cooperation and Assistance Division of any administrative or other problems that may arise in connection with the attendance of any participant.
